

- He is Sundar Pichai.
- He was born on 10 June 1972 in Madurai, Tamil Nadu, India.
- He is the chief executive officer (CEO) of Alphabet Inc. and its subsidiary Google.
- He was selected to become the CEO of Google on August 10, 2015.
- He began his career as a materials engineer.
- He joined Google in 2004, where he led the product management and innovation efforts for a suite of Google's client software products, including Google Chrome and Chrome OS, as well as Google Drive.
- In 2010, he also announced the open-sourcing of the new video codec VP8 by Google and introduced the new video format, WebM.
- In 2012, The Chromebook was released and in 2013, he added Android to the list of Google products.
- He was included in *Time*'s annual list of the 100 most influential people in 2016 and 2020.
- He received the Padma Bhushan in the category of Trade and Industry from the Government of India in 2022.
