- He is Alfred Nobel.
- He was born in Stockholm, Sweden on October 21, 1833.
- He was a scientist, inventor, entrepreneur, and businessman.
- He is best known for inventing dynamite and the blasting cap.
- He left the majority of his fortune to establish the Nobel Prizes which honor people for outstanding achievements in Physics, Chemistry, Physiology or Medicine, literature, and peace.
- He was also fluent in several languages, including English, Swedish, French, German, and Russian.
- He died of a cerebral hemorrhage at his villa in San Remo, Italy, on December 10, 1896.
